Professional licensure candidates will demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the principles of reading and writing instruction at all levels including the reading and writing process, skills and strategies, phonemic awareness and phonics, instructional approaches, instructional materials, and informal assessment as well as effective instructional strategies for all learners within a variety of academic content areas. "All learners" include school age children with developmental variations and learning disabilities as well as second language learners throughout the stages of development. A strong focus of the course is integrating research, theory and practice in the teacher's current classroom. **Information regarding the required texts, text fees (approximately \$185), will be provided in advance of the course start date.**
