

TEACHERS...STILL NEED TO EARN YOUR PROFESSIONAL LICENSE?
FREC IS ENROLLING NOW FOR JANUARY 2012 . . .

Attention...Elementary Education, Grades 1-6; Early Childhood Education, PreK-2; Math, Grades 5-8; and Teachers of Students with Moderate Disabilities, Grades PreK-8 and 5-12.

Please be advised that French River Education Center (FREC) is approved by the MA Department of Elementary & Secondary Education (DESE) to offer area teachers a low cost, high quality, *alternative pathway* to a professional license in your discipline---**one that does not require a Masters degree.**

If you hold an initial license and currently teach:

~Elementary Education, 1-6; Early Childhood Education, PreK-2/3; or Math, Grades 5-8: you need only to take two (2) DESE approved program courses: a math (January 2012) course and a literacy (September 2012) and **you will have your professional license by mid-December 2012** provided you have already completed three (3) years of teaching, if you have not done so already. Your total cost: approximately \$2,600 to earn your professional license---and, again, you do not have to get a Masters. You save time (10-12 graduate courses for a Masters) and money (\$14,000-\$16,000 plus on campus fees for a Masters) with our program.

~Moderate Disabilities, PreK-8/9 or 5-12: you need only to take three (3) DESE approved program courses: a math (January 2012) course; a week-long summer special education course (end of June 27, 2012) on inclusion; and a literacy (September 2012) course, and **you will have your license program by mid-December, 2012** provided you have already completed three (3) years of teaching, if you have not done so already. Your total cost: approximately \$3,600 to earn your professional license---and, again, you do not have to get a Masters. You save time (10-12 graduate courses for a Masters) and money (\$14,000-\$16,000 plus on campus fees for a Masters) with our program.

More than 190 area teachers have completed our DESE approved professional license program with another 24 teachers set to complete their professional license program requirements in December 2012.
